Driving Range:

Due to the circumstances of the driving range following practice rules apply:

- Use of Drivers is not allowed.
- Front part: Play only from the mats (Gras tees are closed)
- Back part: Gras tees are open for strokes up to a maximum of 200 meters

Additional training possibilities – also for long strokes and drivers:

- Romantic Course in Seltenheim (e.g. hole 4) only with your own balls
- Golfakademie Moosburg in Gradenegg 41, 9062 Gradenegg: There will be a reserved box with unlimited balls for Euro 10,-/person (payable in GC Moosburg).

SCORING: ELECTRONIC SCORECARD:

GOLF AUSTRIA APP: Free download from the Apple and Google Play Store for Electronic Scorecard.

Use of Electronic Scorecards: According to rule 3.3, the competition organizers can provide for (prescribe) the use of electronic scorecards. According to rule 3.3b/3, the player must inform the competition committee if there is an electronic or other defect and thus the player can also submit his score via a non-electronic scorecard.

In principle, the use of the electronic score card is binding. If a player has problems using it, he or she must contact the competition management and, if necessary, will be given a score card.

Please check about 60 minutes before your start time that the transmission of the ESC to your phones is correct.

Scoring Area:

The scoring area is at the golf reception. After the round has ended, the electronic scorecards must be compared in the scoring area and handed in there, as well as the non-electronic scorecards.
